No Smoking or Vaping

To support rest and privacy, we ask guests to respect quiet hours between 10pm and 8am.

Please avoid loud music or disruptive noise, especially in shared hallways or near open windows.

Damage & Repairs

If something is accidentally damaged or not working as expected, please let us know promptly so we can assist or repair it. Any damage or cleaning needs beyond standard use may incur a charge, in line with our terms of stay.

Sustainability & Housekeeping

Each SLO residence is designed with a low-impact approach in mind, from materials and air systems to the way we care for your space.

To reduce unnecessary waste, linens and towels are refreshed during our weekly clean. If you'd like fresh items in between, additional changes can be booked as an extra at any time.

Recycling bins are provided in each residence for your convenience, and we appreciate your help in disposing of waste thoughtfully. As procedures may vary by property, please refer to your check-in instructions for specific guidance on rubbish and recycling during your stay.

Your residence is secured with a digital access system. When leaving, simply ensure the door is fully closed behind you. Access codes are automatically deactivated after your check-out time.

Period proportions meet contemporary design, layered with natural materials, custom furnishings and bespoke lighting. Every detail, from the joinery to the air filtration system, has been designed to support how you actually live.

Our renovation focused on what you can feel, but may not see: acoustic insulation, low-toxicity paints and finishes, filtered air, and smart climate control. You'll notice it in the stillness, the comfort, the quality of light.

British craftsmanship grounds every space, with curated furniture from names like Galvin Brothers and Robin Myerscough, textiles woven in the UK, and artwork by emerging and established London-based artists.

This is more than a renovation. It's the beginning of SLO living.

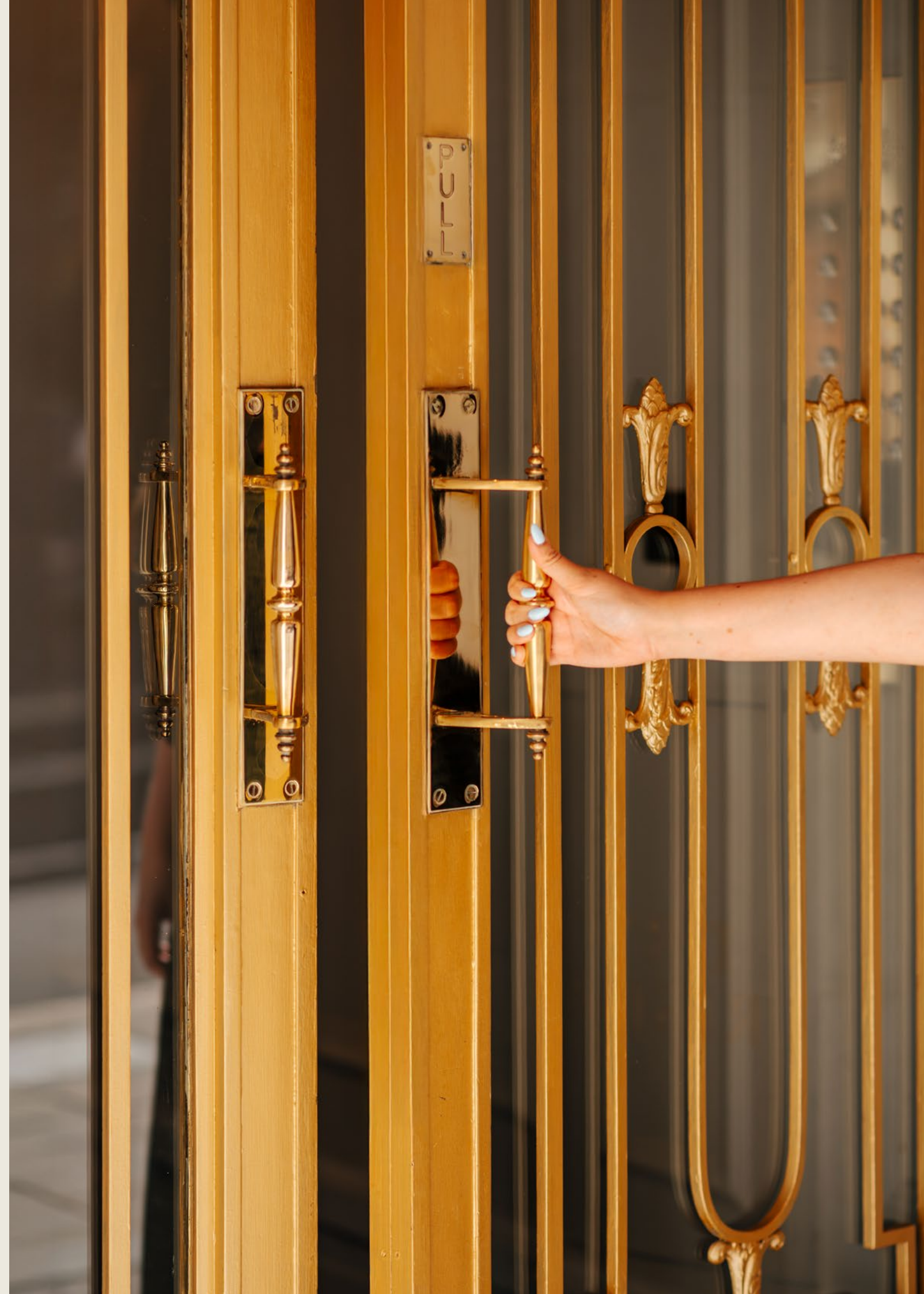

Discover Mayfair

Mayfair is one of London's oldest estates, developed in the 1720s, named after a fair that once filled these streets each May. Three centuries later, the proportions remain Georgian, the squares still leafy, the pace still a little slower than the city around it.

You're staying in the quieter heart of it. Davies Street connects Grosvenor Square to Berkeley Square, two of London's finest garden squares, both minutes from your door. The Elizabeth Line at Bond Street has made this one of the best-connected corners of the city. And yet it still feels like a village.



A neighbourhood of makers

What we love about Mayfair is how much still happens here by hand.



Farm Shop on South Audley Street is the London outpost of Durslade Farm in Somerset—a working 1,000-acre farm that supplies the counter. The rotisserie chicken is legendary. The basement wine bar, unmarked from outside, is one of the area’s genuine secrets.



Sautter on Mount Street has sold cigars and accessories for over fifty years. Whether you smoke or not, the wood-panelled interior is worth a look.



Mount Street Printers has been producing fine stationery in the same spot since 1981. Wedding invitations, personal correspondence, business cards, all typeset and pressed the old way.



HR Higgins on Duke Street has been roasting coffee since the 1940s. They supply some of London’s best restaurants. Their basement café is tiny, unchanged, and quietly perfect.

Green Space

Mayfair sits between two Royal Parks.

Hyde Park is five minutes West via Upper Brook Street—350 acres, open from 5am, with the Serpentine Lake at its heart. Runners, swimmers, rowers, dog walkers. Henry VIII hunted here. Now it’s London’s green lung.

Green Park is eight minutes South via Half Moon Street. Open 24 hours, quieter, hillier. No formal flowerbeds—just grass and mature trees sloping down toward Buckingham Palace.

Between the parks and the squares, you’re never far from stillness.

Hidden in plain sight

Mayfair rewards those who look up and wander slowly.

Mount Street Gardens sits behind the Church of the Immaculate Conception, shaded by London planes. It was a burial ground until the 1850s. Now it’s benches, birdsong, and one of the only places in W1 where you can hear yourself think.

Brown Hart Gardens is a rooftop garden above an electricity substation on Duke Street. Most Londoners don’t know it exists. You’ll find roses, pergolas, and a view across to Selfridges.

The Audley on Mount Street has stood since 1888, a grand Victorian pub recently restored, with a Phyllida Barlow mosaic covering the ceiling. Walk-in only, always buzzing.

Shepherd Market is a tangle of narrow lanes just South of Curzon Street, pubs, restaurants, a Victorian village atmosphere that feels nothing like the rest of Mayfair.

Grosvenor Square was once the most prestigious address in London. The American Embassy stood here for decades. Now the square is being returned to gardens, and the neighbourhood is breathing again.

Where Creativity Lives

Mayfair has one of the highest concentrations of galleries in the world, many within a few minutes' walk. On Davies Street alone, you'll pass Sadie Coles HQ and Gray MKT. The Royal Academy anchors Burlington House. Hauser & Wirth, Gagosian, David Zwirner, White Cube, all nearby.

Most are free to enter. No tickets, no queues. Just walk in.

The art in your apartment was curated in collaboration with Clare Mander and the British Arts Council, emerging and established UK artists whose work you can live with, not just look at.

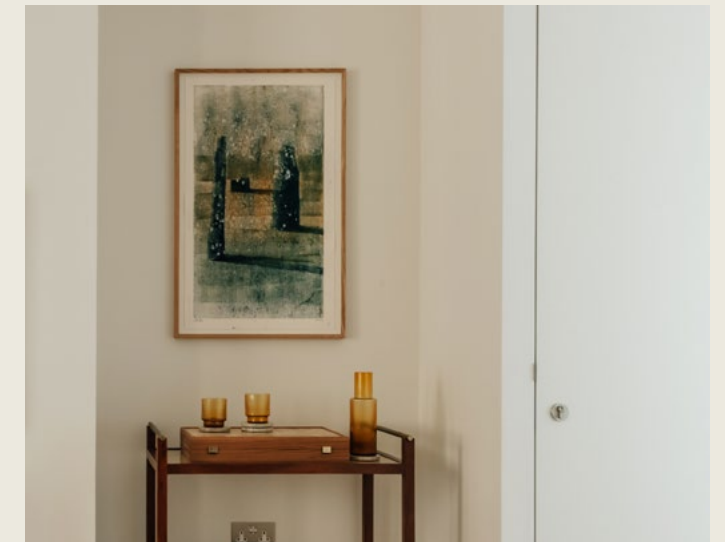

The Slumber Bedside Table in Berry Red from NiX by Nicola Harding is a generously sized, two-tiered bedside (or side) table crafted from FSC-certified beech with solid turned legs and a deep, discreet drawer for subtle storage.



The Twin Polygon Oval Table is a distinctive handcrafted dining table made from solid hardwood, featuring a unique twin pedestal base with polygonal shaping that blends sculptural presence with everyday practicality. Designed and made in Yorkshire, UK, it reflects Galvin Brothers’ dedication to

traditional joinery, craftsmanship, and honest materiality. Its oval top offers a softer, more sociable shape ideal for dining spaces, while the bold base creates architectural interest. The piece exemplifies the studio’s ethos of “furniture for the 21st-century home” — functional, characterful, and built to last.



The Anecdote Pedestal Table by Nicola Harding’s NiX collection is a compact, sculptural side table crafted from FSC-certified European oak and hand-finished to highlight its natural grain. Designed for versatility and everyday use, its understated form offers both beauty and function, fitting seamlessly into layered interiors. Made in small batches in Portugal, it reflects a commitment to sustainability, craftsmanship, and timeless design. Inspired by real-life design needs, it’s a quiet yet purposeful piece meant to support daily rituals and spark conversation.



The Aurora Dining Table by Mythology is a striking sculptural piece handcrafted from solid English oak, recognized for its hollow conical base shaped using traditional coopering techniques and hand-carved with a wave motif that preserves visible chisel marks. The tabletop features a deep beveled edge, lending it visual lightness and refined elegance. Offered in two sizes (approximately 145 cm or 180 cm diameter) with a standard height around 74–75 cm, each table is made to order and can be customized in finish or dimensions. With a lead-time of roughly 10–12 weeks, this limited-edition design embodies a thoughtful blend of nature-inspired form, artisan craft, and timeless functionality.

The Lapis Double Hoop by Dea Domus is a striking stoneware vessel crafted in 2024, featuring a central narrow-necked form flanked by two expansive lateral hoops. It's wheel-thrown and explores sculptural balance—melding functional form with surreal, myth-inspired artistry. Created by Sophie Frost (Dea Domus), the piece draws on her background in fine art and studio pottery, reflecting a dialogue between drawing and making, ancient object motifs, and emotional shapes. At 20.5 cm tall and 36 cm wide, it's a bold, contemplative work that blurs the line between vessel and sculpture.



The Chess Set in Olivine from The Conran Shop is a beautifully crafted, portable wooden chess set featuring olive-green tulip wood pieces and a complementary board framed in oak. Inside the hinged board lies a soft fabric-lined compartment for neat storage, making it both stylish and practical. Hand-made in Greece, this set blends natural materials with refined design, ideal for both play and display. Presented in a compact 40 cm square format and finished in soothing Olivine tones, it's a lasting piece that adds elegance to any home.

The Porta Romana Button Lamp (Large – Lagoon) is a hand-crafted glazed ceramic table lamp inspired by ancient Mesopotamian pottery. Its distinctive feature is an irregularly studded surface, created by applying a syrup of glaze over raised “button” textures, which gives it tactile depth and visual intrigue.



Standing approximately 17” high (28½” with shade), it’s available in multiple earthy tones and typically paired with a 14” linen shade to soften its sculptural presence. Made in the UK and finished to order in around eight weeks, this lamp combines timeless ceramic craft with flexible, bespoke design.



The Orcia Framed Wall Art – Multi from OKA is a 95 × 64 cm framed canvas print featuring an abstract, hand-enhanced depiction of tulip-like forms in soft, hazy tones outlined with delicate black lines. Each piece is enlivened with hand-applied brushstroke embellishments, giving it unique texture and making every artwork subtly distinct. Encased in a contemporary wooden frame, it’s designed to bring warmth and artistic flair to interiors while offering a personal touch through its minimalist botanically inspired composition. Ideal as a serene yet sophisticated focal point, it merges artisanal craftsmanship with modern elegance—perfect for accentuating living spaces with character and calm.



The ****Signature Desk**** by Galvin Brothers is a minimalist, handcrafted desk crafted in England from your choice of natural oak, ebonised oak, or walnut, available in three widths (100–140 cm) to suit tidy home offices and creative studios. Subtle yet smart, it features a leather sling beneath the top, perfect for stowing papers or a laptop out of sight. Designed as part of their Signature range—which includes matching benches and tables—the desk embodies the brand’s ethos of clean-lined utility and thoughtful craftsmanship. Made to order in East Yorkshire with a 10–12 week lead time, it can also be customized in dimensions, timber, or finish for bespoke projects.

How We Measure Our Environmental Footprint

SLO has developed a rigorous, transparent ESG (Environmental, Social & Governance) framework rooted in international standards (GHG Protocol, DEFRA, ISO 14064). The goal is simple: measure the carbon footprint of every stay and continuously improve. We assess a guest’s stay across intuitive categories:

1. Airport Transport

We calculate emissions from how guests travel to SLO and offer guidance on lower-impact routes and options. Small choices make a big difference.

2. In-Stay Transport

Our central locations help reduce dependence on taxis or long travel distances, encouraging walking, cycling and public transport.

3. Diet & Dining

Food is one of the most important contributors to emissions. We evaluate daily dietary patterns and promote delicious, low-impact options through curated local partners.

4. Cooking vs Dining Out

Cooking at home, a luxury made easy in our residences, has a significantly lower footprint than restaurant dining. Our kitchens and pantry essentials help guests make sustainable choices effortlessly.

5. Housekeeping

Each cleaning session has a carbon cost. SLO offers guest-controlled housekeeping designed to balance immaculate spaces with reduced environmental impact.

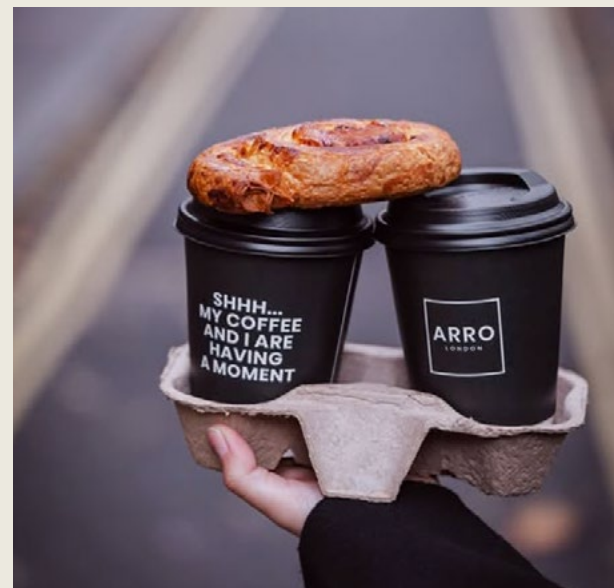
6. Building Emissions

Our Mayfair flagship underwent a deep, sustainable retrofit, dramatically reducing energy use while preserving historical character. We measure both:

Operational carbon: energy used during your stay.

Embodied carbon: emissions linked to construction materials over the building’s lifetime.

This scientific, transparent approach is rare in the hospitality world, and it ensures that our sustainability story is not just elegant, but credible.

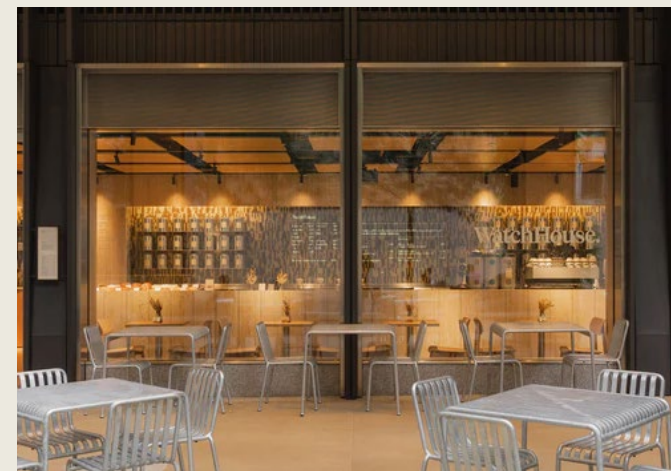
